Medicines in School

The Local Authority has published some new guidelines that we must follow. So from after half term onwards we will not be allowed to administer medicines of any sort unless they have been prescribed by a doctor. Medicines purchased without prescription should not be brought into school at all. Any prescribed medicines should be taken at home if at all possible. For example medicines that need to be taken 3 times a day should be taken before school, just after school and at bed-time. Obviously medicines that need to be taken 4 times a day or before meals could be administered in school. All medicines should be handed in to the school office

The teaching support staff here at Birstall Primary School work extremely hard on behalf of your children. They are dedicated, committed and are a great support to both pupils and staff. Recently we have had a few incidents where pupils and parents have not behaved in an appropriate way towards these valued members of staff.
